BROWSER FEATURES

IncentViz uses a browser-based interface therefore many standard browser functions can be utilized while using IncentViz.

Zoom In/Out (enlarge/contract)

- Use the Zoom feature in the browser menu to scale the content.
- Use the wheel on your mouse. Hold down the Ctrl key and spin the mouse wheel to scale the content.

Open New Form / Tab

Multiple forms can be opened simultaneously in IncentViz by launching the form in a new tab on the browser.

- Hold down the Ctrl key while clicking on an IncentViz menu selection or Action Button to open a new form and tab.
- Hover over a menu selection or Action Button and right-click. Select desired the option (open new tab, open new window, copy link) from the browser menu.

Open a Duplicate copy of the Current Form

The same form can be opened multiple times in IncentViz. To open a duplicate copy of a form, most browsers offer a Duplicate option.

- Hover over the desired browser tab at the top of the browser window, then *right-click* and select Duplicate to open the same form in a new tab.
- Highlight & copy the current form URL, open a new tab in the browser and paste the URL into the new browser tab. This will open another copy of the form.

Back to Previous Form / History

Using the standard "back" feature in your browser, you can return to a previous form that was opened. In addition, you can utilize the History menu in your browser to jump to a previously opened form.

Vertical Scrolling

Most of the forms in IncentViz display data that requires more than space than is provided on the monitor. Use the vertical scroll bar (right side of window) to scroll and view more content or data displayed in the window.

INCENTVIZ FIELD FEATURES

Filter Fields


Many forms within IncentViz have fields for which a specific record or a group of records can be retrieved. For example, if Cust Name or Cust ID is a field available on a form, by populating this field, IncentViz will retrieve all Customer records of the value specified that have records in the current form.

Date Field

Data can be entered into a Date field by placing the cursor at the desired location in the field and overriding the data. A calendar feature can also be accessed by clicking on the calendar button on the right side of the field.

QUOTA CREDIT & PAYMENTS PERIOD FILTER

An additional feature is available on these typw forms when setting the date or filter value on the Start or End Date on these forms. While hovering over a date field, right-click to access the Period Submenu.



From this menu you can select any of the above periods for which the data will be filtered.

Pulldown Lists

Data in a pulldown list, such as a Salesperson, can be selected using one of two methods.


- Click on the triangle on the right side of the pulldown list then using your mouse wheel, scroll until the desired value is identified and left-click to select.
- Quickly jump to a value by clicking on the triangle on the right side of the pulldown list then begin typing. The point in the list will immediately jump to the key combination typed in.

INCENTVIZ GRIDVIEWS

Many forms within IncentViz utilize Grid Views to display the data. Grid Views display data in a table format of rows and columns very similar to what is displayed in a spreadsheet.


Search Filters

Data can be filtered in Grid View using standard IncentViz filtering options (see IncentViz Field Features above). Once the data has been retrieved based on base filtering, further searching, filtering, and sorting can be applied to the Data Table.




Grid View Display

Grid Views have columns with column titles, and each individual record is displayed as a row within the table.




Grid View - Page Control

Typically, a high number of records will accumulate over time, and the number of records will exceed the page length on the grid. The Page Control exists at the bottom of the Grid View.



The number of records on a page can be changed by clicking the Items per Page pop-up list.




Pages can be navigated by clicking the forward and back buttons on the page control.




Grid View - Column Control

In addition to the Search Filters described above, additional features are available for each column in the Grid View.

Columns can be Sorted in Ascending or Descending order and can also be enabled/disabled from displaying in the grid by checking/unchecking the desired column title.



You can also apply individual filters to each column to narrow your search criteria even further using the Filter wizard.



This is helpful when searching for a group or range of records.

GRID VIEW - Details Button

The DETAILS button in the left column of the Grid View provides a form view of the same data in the line that is selected in the Grid View.
